

The Edward Jenner Unit has temporarily moved!

The Edward Jenner Unit at GRH has been fortunate to receive a large donation from the Leukaemia and Intensive Chemotherapy Fund to refurbish and extend the existing services.

In order to facilitate the build, the Edward Jenner Unit will be **relocating to Ward 2b from Monday 13th June until late October 2011.**

This includes **the Haematology, Immunology, Anti-coagulation and Haemoglobinopathy** out-patient and treatment services. **Phlebotomy** services are relocating to a room within the main GRH out-patient area and a mobile facility based at the London Road entrance to the GRH site. Due to space constraints, the MRI is being moved to theatres compound.

The following out-patient clinics will operate from Ward 2b throughout the duration of the works:
